New & Re-envisioned Art Palm Beach 2023 Draws Crowds of Art Lovers – Generating Strong Sales & Buzz!

A fantastic five-day celebration of art, the 2023 edition of Art Palm Beach came to a close at the Palm Beach County Convention Center on Sunday! The newly re-envisioned fair, under the leadership of LA Art Show producer / director Kassandra Voyagis for the first time this year, presented a fresh approach to the West Palm Beach art scene, attracting tens of thousands of art lovers and generating record sales for multiple galleries.

We're pleased the show brought the art community together for such an exciting and engaging experience. Thank you to our exhibiting galleries, our partners, West Palm Beach Mayor Keith James and everyone who attended, for making the Show such a success! In 2022, Art Palm Beach was acquired by the owners of the LA Art Show, infusing the show with a new energy and curatorial vision. "We created a new and completely revamped Art Palm Beach," said Voyagis. "We are so proud of what we accomplished, taking this show in a new and exciting direction. I could tell by the look on people's faces when they walked in that they were wowed by the experience."

Showcasing more than 80 participating exhibiting galleries from the U.S. and worldwide, the fair also introduced the eye-opening debut edition of DIVERSEartPB curated by Marisa Caichiolo, exploring the theme of climate change. In addition, Art Palm Beach presented seven notable featured exhibitions, including artist Lorenzo Marini's engaging and vibrant immersive experience, "Raintype," a crowd favorite.

We're honored to have partnered with St. Jude as our official charity for 2023. The show kicked-off with a successful VIP Opening Night Premiere benefiting St Jude Children's Research Hospital®. Fifteen percent of proceeds from all ticket sales for the five-day event benefitted St. Jude. From the "yellow" carpet to the four Pablo Picasso works for sale, to Bjørn Okholm Skaarup's grand "Circus" installation, visitors and patrons commented on the energy and fun buzzing through the show. As a part of DIVERSEartPB, international artist Marcos Lutyens presented, "Particles," an immersive trance room focusing on drought. The platform also included, "Echo of Oblivion," an immersive installation by artist Guillermo Vezzosi, inviting visitors to encounter an experiential work of art exploring rising sea levels.

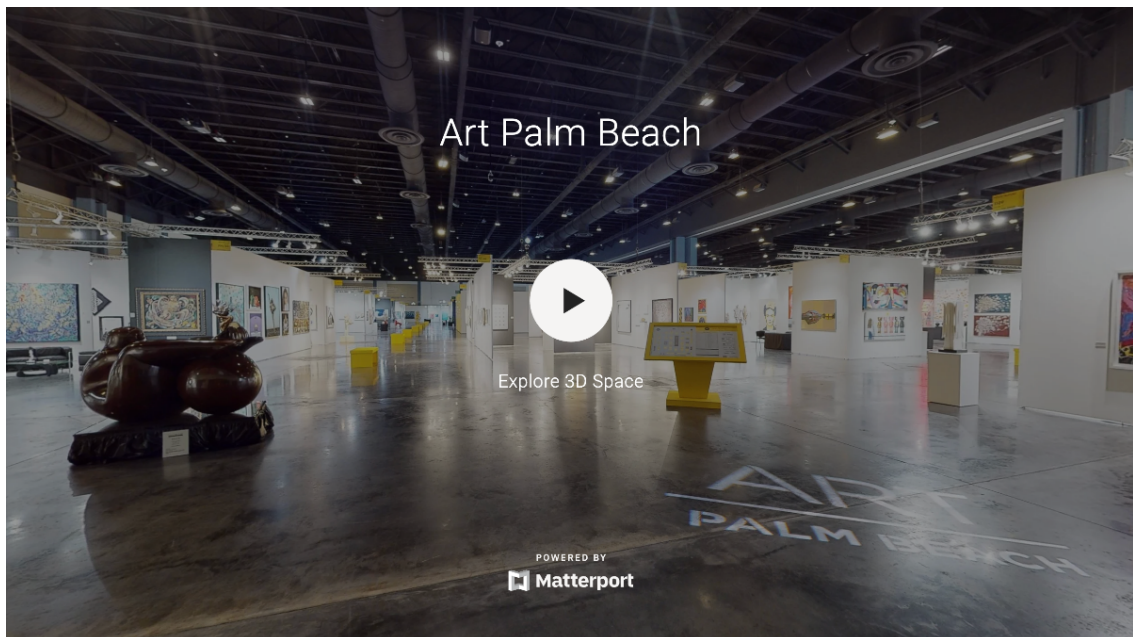

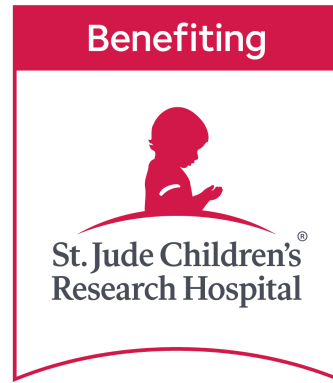
