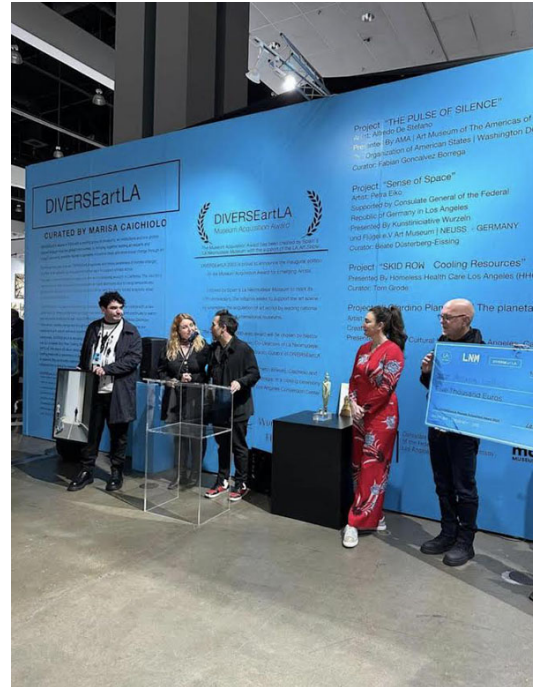
## Sunday, January 28:

Join us for the inaugural edition of the Museum Acquisition Award for Emerging Artists in Palm Beach. Inspired by Spain's La Neomudéjar Museum to mark its 10th anniversary last year in Los Angeles, the initiative seeks to support the art scene by promoting the acquisition of art works by leading national and international museums. The winner of the award will be chosen by Néstor Prieto and Francisco Brieves, Co-Directors of La Neomudéjar Museum, as well as Marisa Caichiolo, Curator of DIVERSEartLA. The award will be presented by Prieto, Brieves, Caichiolo and LA Art Show Director Kassandra Voyagis in a closing ceremony at the fair.

## Featured Exhibition Highlight

**Gregory Scott and Kim Keever**

Presented by Modern Fine Art, New York

Come by and view Gregory Scott and Kim Kever, both featured at Modern Fine Art during Art Palm Beach's final day.

Gregory Scott is known for his fusion of photography, painting, and video. His works involve elaborate sets, props, and actors, including himself, often set within art historical contexts. Scott's art addresses themes like identity and loss, using humor and hand-painted elements that resonate with the content in his video installations. His approach has evolved significantly since pursuing a graduate degree in studio art at Indiana University in 2008, where he began incorporating video into his work.

Kim Kever, on the other hand, brings a scientific approach to his art, drawing from his background in Thermal Engineering and experience at NASA.



Transitioning to art in the 1970s, Kever's signature style involves creating cloud-like abstractions by pouring paint into a 200-gallon water tank and capturing the swirling forms with a large-format digital camera. His work, evolving from romantic landscapes to vibrant abstractions, is presented in large-scale prints, showcasing the captivating interplay of dye and pigment in water.

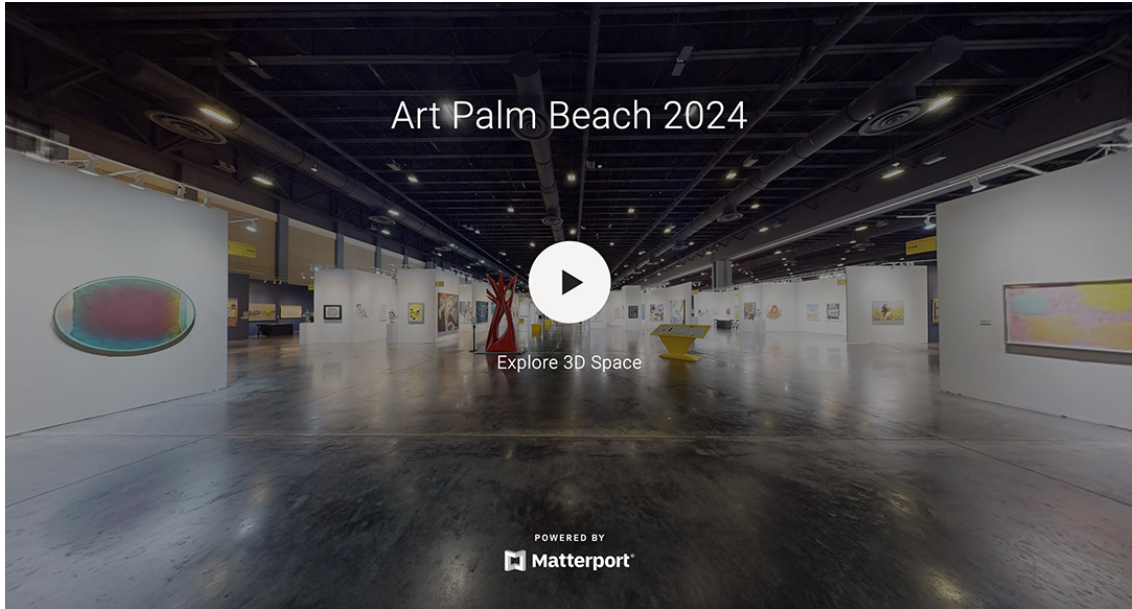

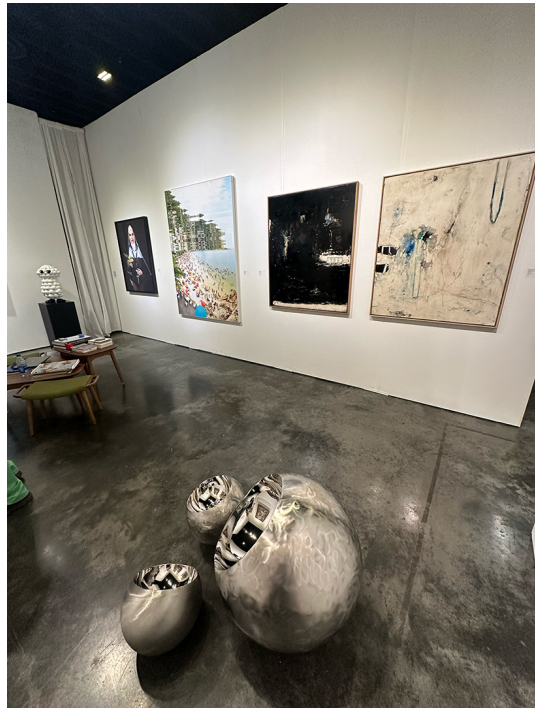

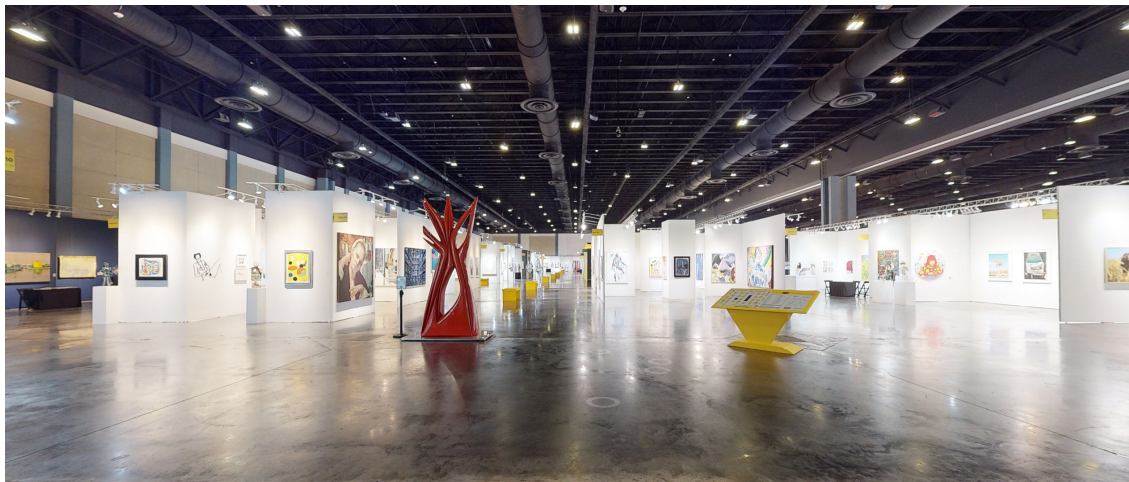
