Art Palm Beach is scheduled to return to the Palm Beach County Convention Center from January 22-26, 2025.

Gallery Highlights

Hollis Taggart, New York

Since its establishment in 1979, Hollis Taggart has been a key player in the presentation of museum-quality American art, spanning from early works by the Hudson River School to modern and contemporary movements. With over 40 years in the field, the gallery has developed a program rooted in scholarship and supported numerous critically acclaimed exhibitions in collaboration with leading experts.

Hollis Taggart has sponsored four notable catalogue raisonné projects, including those for Daniel Garber and Kay Sage, showcasing its commitment to academic contributions in the art world. This endeavor highlights the gallery's role in enhancing understanding of significant art figures.

Transitioning to Chelsea in 2015 from its original Upper East Side location, Hollis Taggart expanded its footprint in 2018 and again in 2022, now offering expansive spaces for exhibitions and private viewings. This move facilitated a closer connection between its operations and its audience.

In 2019, the gallery broadened its scope by incorporating contemporary works into its offerings, alongside its traditional focus on historic American art. This expansion reflects Hollis Taggart's dedication to presenting a comprehensive view of American art's evolution.

Established in 2003 by Christoffer M. Egelund, Galleri Christoffer Egelund stands as a pivotal presence in Copenhagen's historic quarter, recognized for its dedication to highquality Scandinavian and international contemporary art. With a spacious 300 square meter exhibition space, the gallery is ideally situated amidst a vibrant hub of contemporary galleries, the National Gallery of Denmark, and other significant art institutions, asserting its role in Denmark's contemporary art scene.

At its core, the gallery prides itself on an experimental and innovative ethos, striving to push the boundaries of conventional gallery models and the broader art landscape. By showcasing a diverse range of media—including works on paper, photography, paintings, sculptures, performance art, and video—Galleri Christoffer Egelund is committed to presenting unique artistic expressions that resonate with both the art community and the wider public.

C. Grimaldis Gallery, Baltimore

Since its inception in 1977, C. Grimaldis Gallery has carved out a prestigious niche as Baltimore's longest continually operating gallery. Starting with a focus on local and

regional talent, the gallery quickly expanded its vision to include notable international artists such as Grace Hartigan, Elaine de Kooning, Alice Neel, Anne Truitt, and Sir Anthony Caro, among others.

Under the guidance of owner Constantine Grimaldis, the gallery has developed a keen curatorial eye, balancing the promotion of emerging talents like Chul Hyun Ahn, Beverly McIver, Jae Ko, and John Ruppert, with exhibitions of established luminaries including John Baldessari and Willem de Kooning. This approach has allowed C. Grimaldis Gallery to maintain a vibrant and dynamic program that spans modern and contemporary works across all media.

Through its selective roster and engaging programs, C. Grimaldis Gallery continues to foster a spirit of exploration and experimentation, making it a cornerstone of artistic innovation in the region.
